our nation and the world in World War I; where 375,000 Americans were wounded
including 116,516 who perished; and*

*Whereas, many from what was to become Simi Valley served selflessly and
honorably in World War I; and*

*Whereas, an armistice to the fighting was declared on November 11,
1918 and the U.S. World War One Centennial Commission has called upon
Americans across the nation to honor and remember those who served.*

*and calls upon the citizens and institutions in our community to toll the bells in remembrance of
the Armistice at 11:00 a.m. on November 11, 2018.*
